



#### **TECH TRACK**

In 2021, Ismart started a new project: the **Tech Track**. In partnership with Alura, FEBRACE, IBM and ZUP, it offered content and courses for high school students (in person and online) to learn about the world of technology, programming languages and logic (Python, C++, Java) as well as digital trends . In total, **+760 students were impacted**.



#### It doesn't stop there!

High school students also had access to **tech traning opportunities.** 

+100 university students are developing their skills in current technology tools, with 70 students undergoing Python courses offered by Bloomberg;

#### RISE



Rise is a program that finds brilliant people who need opportunity and supports them for life as they work to serve others. An initiative of Schmidt Futures and the Rhodes Trust, Rise is the Anchor program of a \$1 billion commitment from Eric and Wendy Schmidt to find and support global talent.

The dimension and ambition of the Rise project called Ismart's attention since we've first learned about the initiative. This partnership strengthens our purpose and allows us to get farther. The first edition had participants from more than **170 countries** and among the **100 global winners**, 5 were Brazilian, including **three Ismart fellows!** 

### **VOLUNTEERS AND PARTNERS**

More than **190 professional** individuals and more than **155 companies** took part of programs to develop fellows who are attending college and high school. These partners increased the possibility that **Ismart fellows find a good job**.

Ismart continued to support its network of fellows and families throughout the pandemic. When the public education system suspended classes, Ismart came up with **several initiatives** to stimulate the students' commitment and learning:

-Math Crash Course – offered to more than 400 9th grade students
-Enem Task Fource – through tests in the SAS-Sistema Ari de Sá platform, this task force helped students in the third year of high school to prepare to Brazil's college admission exams.
